How do I manage my account and get COUNTER reports?

The institutional administrator can log in at <http://dashboard.aappublications.org>. In the Reports section, COUNTER reports are available online or as downloads for each year and title.

What authentication methods are available?

AAP eBooks supports IP addresses, Athens ID, username/password, and referring URL authentication.

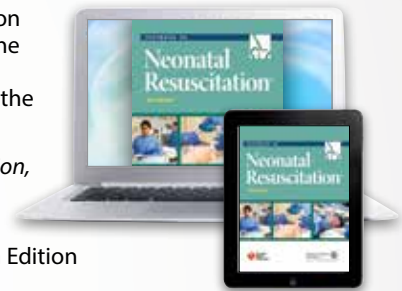

How do I access AAP eBooks?

AAP eBooks supports online access via Internet browser for institutions. Use your current browser and Internet connection on any device. It's that simple.

If supported by your institution, you may also access AAP eBooks off-line through your tablet, smartphone, or media player running **iOS** or **Android** using the **free AAP eBooks Reader app** available from www.aapebooks.org/content/mobile.

Log in with the account provided by your institutional administrator or your AAP login to see the titles available to download.



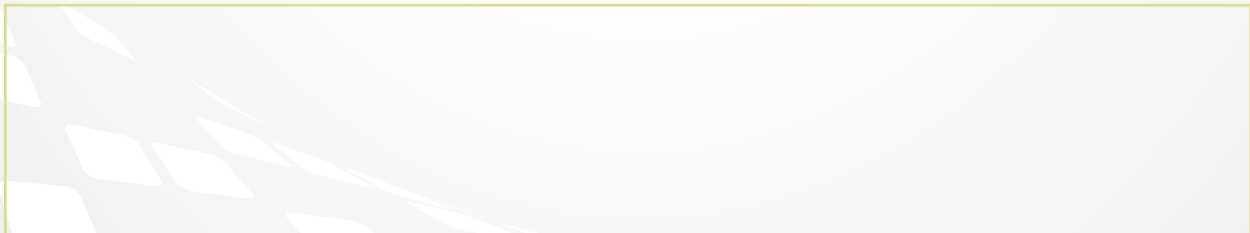
For access on Android tablets, such as the Kindle Fire or Barnes & Noble Nook, with a primary app store other than Google Play, go to **Settings > Applications** and make sure **"Apps from Unknown Sources" is turned on**; then open the AAP eBooks Google Play link in your device browser and install (requires a Google Play account).

What are the benefits of AAP eBooks?

Titles from AAP eBooks are fully searchable; users may print one page at a time, bookmark using browser or app tools, and share links via e-mail and social networks. Several titles include videos that can be streamed from links in the online and app versions.
